## Psalm 84

### **CLERGY**

1620s (also in early use as an adjective), from Church Latin clericus "clergyman, priest," noun use of adjective meaning "priestly, belonging to the clerus ;" from Ecclesiastical Greek klerikos "pertaining to an inheritance," but in Greek "of the clergy, belonging to the clergy," as opposed to the...

**LAITY**; from kleros "a lot, allotment; piece of land; heritage, inheritance," originally "a shard or wood chip used in casting lots," related to klan "to break"

**CLERGY:** I read because I can. I belong.

**LAITY:** You listen and agree with everything I say because I am smart and you are not. You are pretty much a plank of old wood. Sort of not even a good piece of the wood. Knotty probably and slightly damaged or broken.
